We would like to introduce Doug Higgins as our new Cancer Care Program Coordinator. Doug will be replacing John Brost with whom most of you are familiar from his years of service. Doug has been affiliated with the program since its inception and now going into its ninth year he will be responsible for handling the briefings and enrollment at the individual armories.

As most of you are aware we have had a Cancer Care Program for eight years and over those years more than 1,400 Indiana Guardsmen have enrolled in the program. The benefits of the program have paid out over \$430,000 to date. Some of the highlights of the program are:

- 1) Cash is provided up to \$25,000 per month based on plan.
- 2) Benefits are in addition to any other insurance you have.
- 3) The rate has never been raised on an existing client.
- 4) Program is refundable if not used, based on the time frame in plan.

These are just a few comments from claimants here in Indiana:

We were so grateful that we had this insurance. It relieved us of financial problems at a time that we needed to focus on beating cancer. At this time I am cancer free.
